Accomplishment Highlights



A. TRAINING AND EXTENSION SUPPORT ACTIVITIES

True to its mandate, the Agricultural Training Institute-Regional Training Center VII carries out relevant training courses and training-related activities germane to major Agri-Pinoy Programs on rice, corn, high value crops, organic agriculture, livestock, among others.

CY 2013, the year in review, witnessed the conduct of 109 training and extension activities (Table 1) even as it did realize 13 training and training-related activities, i.e., planned for CY-2012 executed and/or completed in 2013 (Table 2).

Nearly, 1/3 (31.19%) of the center's training and extension activities in 2013 were in support to the Rice Program. This scenario hasn't changed over the years thus it has often been construed that DA-ATI's training and extension program is characteristically rice-centric.. Understandably, this likewise is in keeping with the National Government's declaration of CY 2013 as National Year of Rice.

As this developed,, non-degree training courses, consultative meetings and assessment-workshops which altogether were meant to develop and capacitate the region's rural-based organizations, 4-H Clubs among these, made-up 19.27%. Though, the most requested and sought-after trainings, there were only 2 (1.83%) livestock-related courses held during the year (Figure 1).

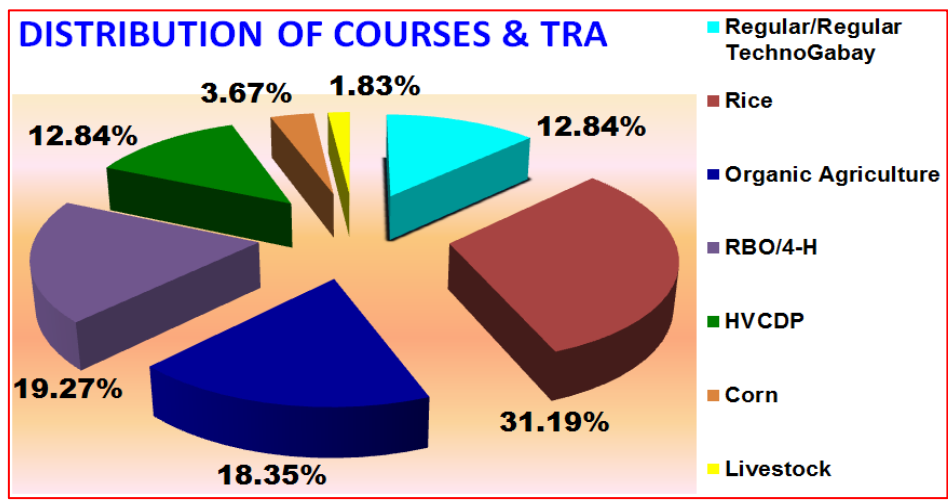

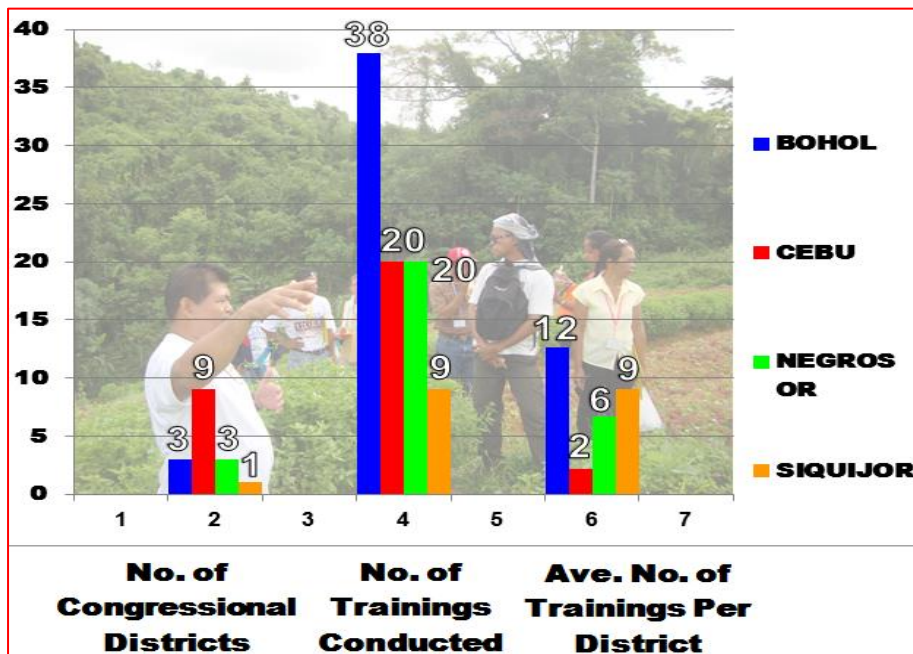


Figure 2. Average Number of Trainings per District, ATI-RTC-VII, CY-2013

On the aggregate, the Province of Bohol had the most number of courses and participants with 38 NOC (34%) and 3,042 NOI (44%), respectively. Cebu's 20 courses were participated in by 1,282 individuals. Negros Oriental had 20 courses that trained 1,483 individuals. There were 9 courses held for and in Siquijor that garnered 251 attendees. About 6,811 individuals were served with 109 trainings in 2013. Notably, the 34 rice support courses reached out to some 3,267 participants (Table 3), the highest across all programs. Figure 2 shows the number of courses conducted per congressional district.

By and large, training expenditures in CY 2013 added up to Php 15,998,259. In the concept of financial resource complementation, the lion share of Php 15,346,991 that contributed 96% of training expenses was borne by ATI-RTC 7. Roughly 4%, specifically Php 651,268 represented the aggregate share of collaborating entities as DA 7, PCARRD and LGUs. HVCDP support courses and training related activities registered the biggest chunk in the training expenditures. Notably, big budgeted activities as Season Long Training and School on the Air were held last year. Training interventions for Agri-Pinoy Rice and Corn Programs also figured hugely in the costing. It's been years, women outnumbered men in terms of attendance to ATI 7 trainings. CY 2013 training roster shows 3,396 male and 3,415 female participants. (Figure 4)

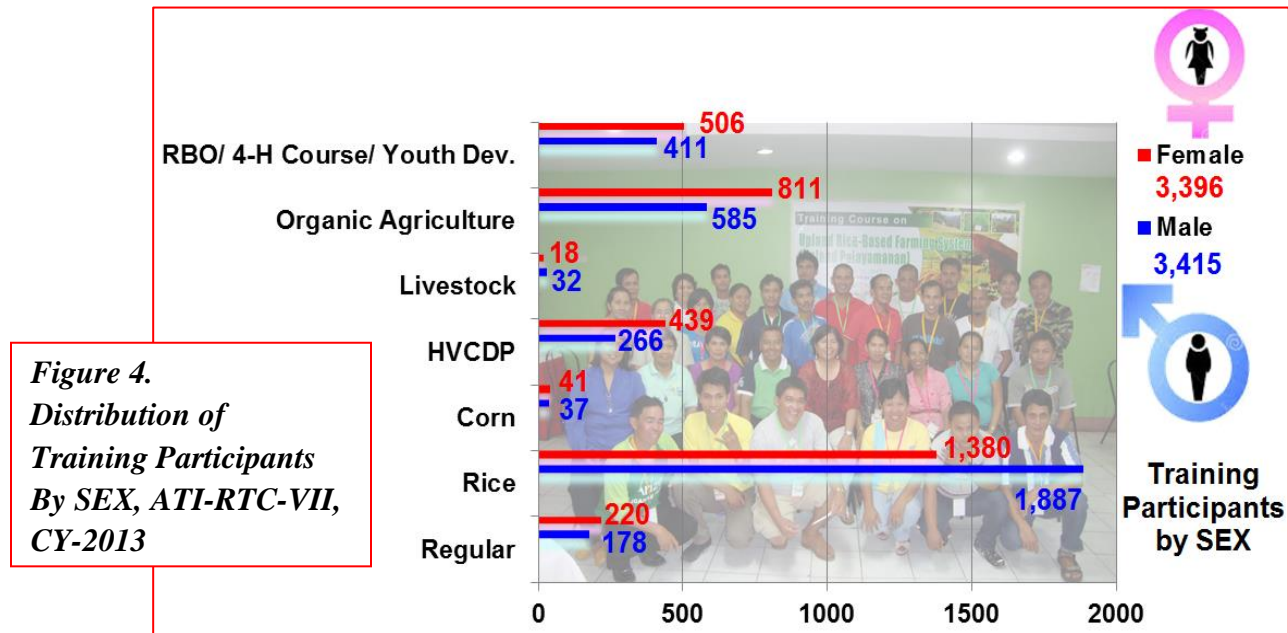

For years, the farmers dominate the center's record of training attendees. Some 3,705 farmers made it to CY 2013 training and other related activities. This is in order as area-specific interventions as technical briefings and Schools on Air are designed primarily for farmers.

Agricultural extension worker-participants in 2013 numbered 1,285. Other clientele served were rural based organization eg. 4H Clubs, rural improvement clubs, indigenous people, rural women, youth and representatives from local government with national government agencies, and non-government organizations. 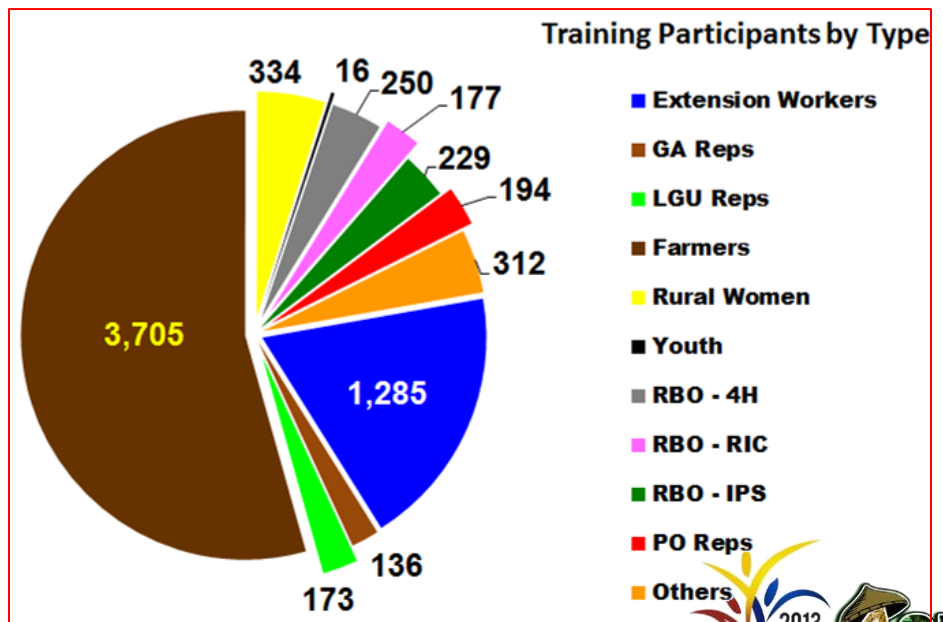

B. REGIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMS

It has often been said that real development is not in the goods and services produced and consumed by man. Development is in and centered around people in man himself as both actor and subject of the development process.

Today, training for agricultural and rural development can be no longer be about increasing production and income only as are the typical and desired end result. It is a core concern to be able to rise to the challenge of becoming responsible agriculture resource managers able to use more prudently scarce public resources emphasizing mitigation of risks and adaptation to changing climate.

B.1 REGULAR COURSES

There were 14 regular courses conducted. The Provincial Consultation on Rationalizing Agriculture and Fisheries Training and Extension Concerns held in 4 Provinces of Region 7 served as avenue crafting and validating. Training and Extension Agenda for CY 2013 and beyond. PCARRD-funded, the Provincial Consultative Meetings on Techno-Gabay Program – Farmers Information Technology Service (FITS) convened the Magsasaka Siyentista, FITS Manager, among others to ascertain status of program implementation let alone drum up operational issues and concerns, surface training & IEC needs to smoothen transaction process and forge more coordinated efforts in the future.

Indeed, e-learning transcends age as, Basic Computer Course was conceptualized for and participated in by Senior. Citizens. **Appendix 1** lists regular courses undertaken in CY 2013.

B.2 COMMODITY TRAINING PROGRAM

B.2.1 Training and Extension Support to the Rice Program

Central Visayas has yet to become rice self-sufficient. As its positive contribution towards this end, ATI-RTC-VII dished out 34 courses in support to the Rice Program consisting of 16 Municipal/City-wide Technical Briefing and Teknoklinik on Rice for Farmers & AEWs (Agricultural Extension Workers), 3 Briefings on FSSP (Food Staples Sufficiency Program) Credit Discipline (SIKATSAKA) and 15 non-degree courses.

Specifically, the non-degree courses hovered around: Climate Change Adaptation in Rice, Rice Seed Production, Certification for Seed Growers Accreditation, Ratooning Technology and other Rice-based Multiple Cropping Technologies, Upland Rice-based Farming System, Climate Field School, Local Farmer Technician Training (Phases 1 & 11), among others (*Appendix 2*).





B.2.2 Training and Extension Support to the Corn Program

With 4 courses held in 2013, 1 course was training support for FSTP in Bohol, three (3) others had region-wide participation. Training on Corn By Product Utilization & Processing got a perfect 30 attendance, very low turn-out of participants was noted in the Refresher and Accreditation Course for Corn Seed Growers-Rarely held, the season-long Training-Of-Trainers on IPM corn merited 21 participants (*Appendix 3*).

B.2.3 Training and Extension Support to High Value Crops Development Program

Vegetable Production pertinent courses include: Training of Trainers on Bulb Onion Production, 1 Season-long Training of Trainers on IPM Vegetable Production, and three (3) Farmer Field Schools on Vegetable Production.

As coffee and cacao are among the region's priority industrial crops, the center made it a point to hold Production Technology Trainings for Coffee and Cacao. The realization that there is more to cacao than *tablea* making is further enhanced with the Training in Cacao Bean Processing.

Trainings for alternate staple include Adlai Production Technology meant to create awareness about such crop and Training on Soybean Production and Postharvest Technology to encourage growing of said crop in our localities.

The center managed to run SOA on Package of Technology for Sustainable Fruit Production. HVCDP course details on *Appendix 4*.

B.2.4 Organic Agriculture Program-Courses and Extension Support Activities

ATI-RTC 7 needs to be persistent in its effort to push for, uphold and in fact go Organic. For 2013, it was able to hold 20 trainings and training related activities in support to the country's Organic Agriculture (OA) Program. These delved on Technical Briefings on OA, SOA on Sustainable Agriculture Development & Organic Farming Technology, Appreciation Courses on OA, Understanding Philippine National Standards, Internal Control System Phases 2 & 3, Integrated Diversified Organic Farming Systems and OA Inputs Production Technology (*Appendix 5*).

Organic Agriculture learning sites were likewise established and managed center-based and in selected areas of Region 7.

B.2.5 Livestock Program Training and Extension Support

As can be gleaned from *Appendix 6*, the Training Course on Goat Raising/ Production and Management was attended by 24 farmers in the Municipality of Tabogon, Cebu. Some 26 new AEWs in the region enrolled themselves in the Livestock and Poultry Production Training that emphasized among others on Disease Outbreak Investigation and Management





B.2.6 Training & Extension Support to RBO/4-H Youth Development Program

Taking cognizance of the fact that rural based organizations as 4-H Clubs, Rural Improvement Clubs, among others, are among the multiple stakeholders in agriculture, the development of RBOs takes center stage in ATI-RTC 7 activities.

Thus, the conduct of 21 trainings and related activities (*Appendix 7*) that aims to hone the functional competences and people skills of the youth, women, and farmers in their respective organizations. These took the form of Youth Encampment Seminar, Enhancement Courses, Adopt a Farm Youth Training, Consultative Meetings; Assessment Workshops, Officers' Meetings, Farm Family Congresses, and FSSP Technical Briefings.

Improving Quality Of AFE Knowledge Products And Services

It always makes sense for ATI-RTC-VII to step up its training and extension efforts by continually engaging in responsible knowledge sharing and dissemination. Employing a variety of information, education and communication media, eg., print, radio and internet, among others, the center provides timely information to increase awareness, persuade and bring about change in specific behavior.

If quality is to be equated with relevance, the center's knowledge products and services are customized to the functional needs and technical levels of its clientele-recipients if only to ensure their effectiveness, usefulness and value. Oftentimes, the various IEC materials are translated into local dialect to optimize the impact of knowledge sharing.

Specific accomplishments in these areas include:

 - Uploaded 67 articles on training courses and training-related activities conducted in CY 2013
 - Uploaded 5 blog entries

 - Distributed 18,455 copies of various IEC materials as leaflets, brochures, flyers, handouts on agri-related topics
 - Made available 35 copies of "Malungtarong Panguma" books to 35 farmer-participants to Organic Agriculture (OA) Courses and 35 copies more during its Livestock & Poultry Production Training, and Health & Wellness Encampment.





- Distributed 3,119 e-learning and OA advocacy materials, eg. mono black bags, advocacy notebooks, plastic fans, umbrellas,, individual drinking jugs, etc.

- SOA On Organic Agriculture aired over DYSS 99.9 AM radio station in Cebu City with 563 graduates for Cebu;
 - SOA On Organic Agriculture aired over DYJP 100.1 FM in Jagna, Bohol with 290 farmer-graduates; or Sustainable Fruit Production over radio station DYTR – 1116 KHZ in Tagbilaran City with 366 graduates.
