CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 18th of corosec 2023 between Agricultural Training Institute – Regional Training Center VII of Cabawan District, Tagbilaran City, Bohol, Philippines (hereinafter called "the Entity") of the one part and Dagohoy Military and Security Supply of J.A.  - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iii. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
- iv. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
- 3. In consideration for the sum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Pesos Only (Php 110,000.00) or such other sums as may be ascertained, Dagohoy Military and Security Supply agrees to PROCUREMENT OF ADVOCACY BAG FOR THE ADVOCACY MATERIALS FOR CFIDP ACTIVITIES/TRAININGS in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
