Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
- 3. In consideration for the sum of One Hundred Sixty-One Thousand Pesos Only (Php 161,000.00) or such other sums as may be ascertained, Sandugo Press Marketing and Supplies agrees to PROCUREMENT OF ICT EQUIPMENTS FOR AFTER SUPPORT DURING THE CONDUCT OF DIGITAL FARMERS PROGRAM PACKAGE OF TECHNOLOGY in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
