BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING APPROVAL AND AWARD OF D.E. LINENS AND TEXTILE TRADING AS THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF ADVOCACY BAG AND ADVOCACY HAT FOR ADVOCACY MATERIALS FOR THE CFIDP ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2024 THROUGH NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT – SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT AS ALTERNATIVE MODE OF PROCUREMENT (*Section 53.9 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184*)

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9184 otherwise known as “The Government Procurement Reform Act” created the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) to ensure among others that the procuring entity abides by the standard set forth by the said Act;

WHEREAS, ATI- RTC 7 requested quotation for the procurement of advocacy bag and advocacy hat for advocacy materials for the CFIDP activities for FY 2024 in the amount allocation of **ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND PESOS ONLY (P 127,000.00)**, dated May 2, 2024 under PR No. 2024-05-385;

WHEREAS, in accordance with RA 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, the abovementioned request was published to the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) for online registered bidders on May 4, 2024 under PhilGEPS Ref.No. **10816630**, and ATI 7 website;

WHEREAS, in response to the said posting, 1. AVECILLA TRADING, 2. CURIT SECURITY AND MILITARY SUPPLIES, 3. D.E. LINENS AND TEXTILE TRADING sent their quotations through its BAC Secretariat;

WHEREAS, the Bid Opening was held on 13 May 2024. During the opening of the bid proposal and upon checking of the documentary requirements, AVECILLA TRADING, CURIT SECURITY AND MILITARY SUPPLIES and D.E. LINENS AND TEXTILE TRADING were declared “**eligible**” to participate in the bidding and thus rated as “**passed**” presented as follows:

WHEREAS, the bid proposal/ quotation by the said bidders during the bid opening was then post-evaluated, the TWG conducted careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial requirements as required by Republic Act No. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations. It was found out by the TWG that the bid proposal submitted by **D.E. LINENS AND TEXTILE TRADING** has been found to be “**Responsive**”;



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WHEREAS, the BAC further evaluated the aforementioned bid proposal/ quotation and agreed to adopt the TWG's recommendation and declared **D.E. LINENS AND TEXTILE TRADING** as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder, and have agreed to recommend to the ATI Center Director that said bidder be awarded;


NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to:

- (a) Declare the **D.E. LINENS AND TEXTILE TRADING** as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder with a bid amounting to **ONE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED PESOS ONLY (Php 115,600.00)** for the procurement of advocacy bag and advocacy hat for advocacy materials for the CFIDP activities for FY 2024;
- (b) Recommend Alternative Mode of Procurement through Negotiated Procurement-Small Value Procurement as provided in Sec. 53.9 and Annex H (Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 for the above-cited goods/services; and
- (c) Recommend for approval by the ATI 7 Center Director the foregoing findings/recommendations.




