

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 22nd of May, 2024 between **Agricultural Training Institute - Regional Training Center VII** of Cabawan District, Tagbilaran City, Bohol, Philippines (hereinafter called "the Entity") of the one part and **D.E. LINENS AND TEXTILE TRADING** of 604 Bato Ext., Raxabago St. Brgy. 150 Zone 13, Tondo, Manila, Philippines (hereinafter called "the Supplier") of the other part;

WHEREAS, the Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly **PROCUREMENT OF ADVOCACY BAG AND ADVOCACY HAT FOR ADVOCACY MATERIALS FOR THE CFIDP ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2024** and has accepted the Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of **One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Six Hundred Pesos Only (Php 115,600.00)** (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract hereinafter referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;
 - iii. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
 - iv. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. **Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**
3. In consideration for the sum of **One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Six Hundred Pesos Only (Php 115,600.00)** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **D.E. LINENS AND TEXTILE TRADING** agrees to **PROCUREMENT OF ADVOCACY BAG AND ADVOCACY HAT FOR ADVOCACY MATERIALS FOR THE CFIDP ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2024** in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
4. The **Agricultural Training Institute - Regional Training Center VII** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
