 - ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iii. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
- iv. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.
- 3. In consideration for the sum of **Two Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Pesos Only (Php 281,460.00)** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **SEAWEED INTERNATIONAL EXPORTS INCORPORATED** agrees to **PROCUREMENT OF ADVOCACY TSHIRT AND POLOSHIRT FOR THE ADVOCACY MATERIALS FOR 2ND SEM 2024 TRAININGS UNDER FUND 01** in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
- 4. The **Agricultural Training Institute Regional Training Center VII** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
