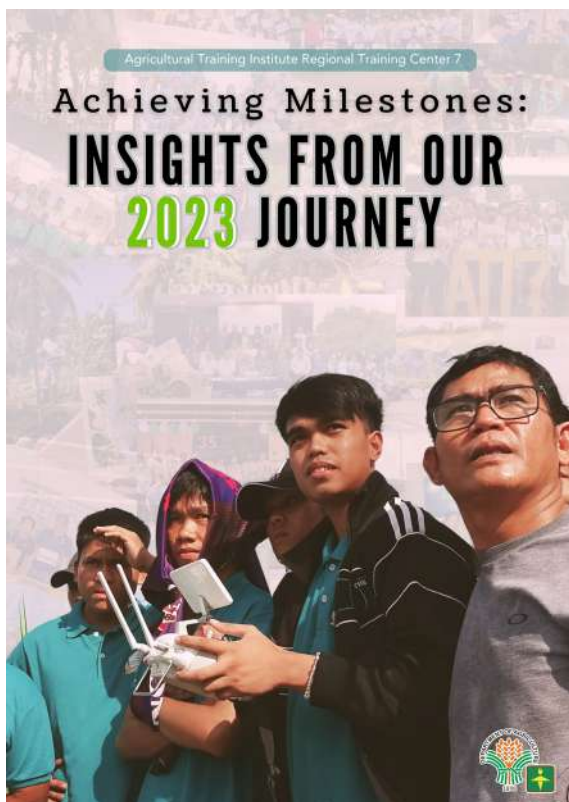


#### **Achieving Milestones: Insights from our 2023 Journey**

# Corn and Cassava

The Corn and Cassava Program of ATI in Central Visayas is one of the commodities with unique innovations. One of which was the Webinar dubbed as Cornversations: **"Will you be my biocon?"** which ran via the center's official Facebook Page last July 21, 2023. This activity coincided with the Corn Month Celebration where the discussion delved into the world of corn and explored the significant advancements made in its biological control.

# Organic Agriculture

The implementation of the Organic Agriculture Program (OAP) in Central Visayas involved various training sessions, including one that earned participants 10 Continuing Professional Development (CPD) units from the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC).

Specifically, the Gender-Based Organic Agriculture Production Technologies training took place from March 6-10, 2023, at ATI-RTC 7, Cabawan District, Tagbilaran City, with the attendance of 18 Agricultural Extension Workers (AEWs) and 2 farmers.

Additionally, the OAP conducted several training sessions and activities, engaging a total of 116 participants, including 14 AEWs and 84 farmers. Notable activities include:

Two Batches of Training for Certified Participatory Guarantee System Groups Towards Accreditation as Organic Certifying Bodies held on June 12-16, 2023, at Julsams Pension House and Function Hall, Bayawan City, Negros Oriental, and on August 7-11, 2023, at ATI-RTC 7 Training Complex, Cabawan District, Tagbilaran City.

Two Batches of Training of Trainers on Participatory Guarantee System (PGS) held on February 13-22, 2023, at Plaza Maria Luisa, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental, and May 8-17, 2023, at Golden Prince Hotel and Suites, Acacia St, Cebu City, Cebu.

An Information Caravan, Orientation, and Contract Signing on the Provision of Youth Scholarship Grant on Organic Farming was conducted on March 27, 2023, at ATI-RTC 7 Training Complex, Cabawan District, Tagbilaran City, Bohol.

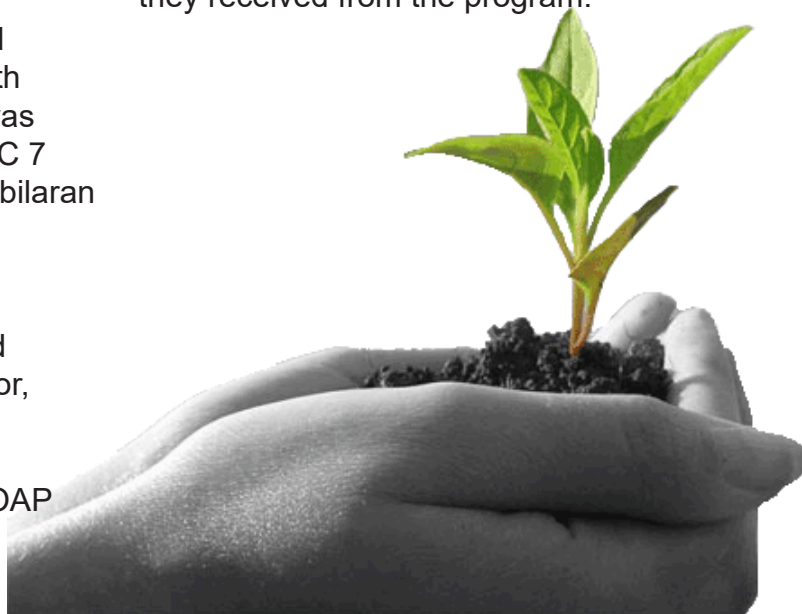

Another notable accomplishment of the OAP

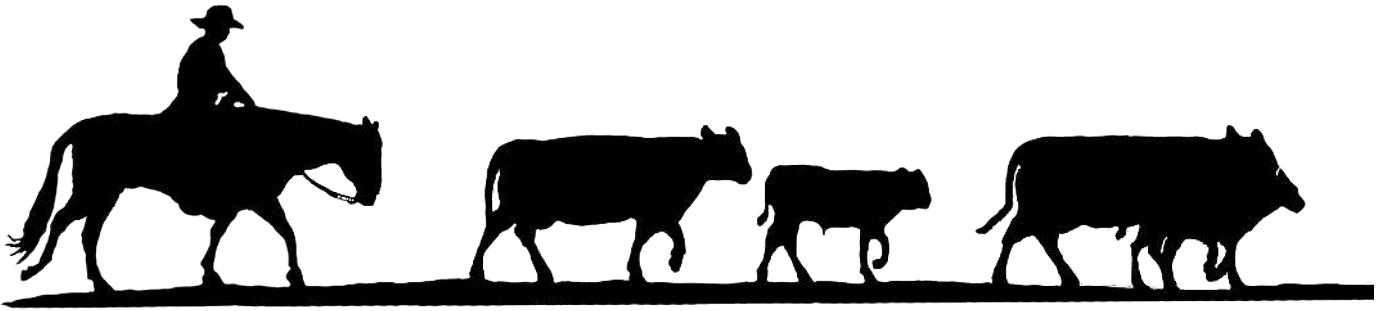


in Central Visayas was the support provided for the certification of five members of Bohol Participatory Guarantee System Association as certified organic practitioners. Currently, BPGSA is actively pursuing the establishment as an organic certifying body itself, granting them the ability to certify fellow farmers as certified organic practitioners.

Moreso, eight (8) youth grantees had successfully completed a rigorous 9-month internship with organic agriculture practitioner-farm partners. Throughout this immersive experience, the scholars engaged in hands-on learning at designated agricultural sites, gaining invaluable insights into the intricacies of OA practices. Presently, these scholars are putting their acquired knowledge into action by launching their individual agri-enterprises, utilizing the 150,000 Philippine pesos grant they received from the program.







## Livestock Program

The Livestock Program in the region is the top grossing operation in terms of financial allocation. This is because of the multi-million peso projects on swine, which are the Swine Multiplier and Demonstration Farm Projects.

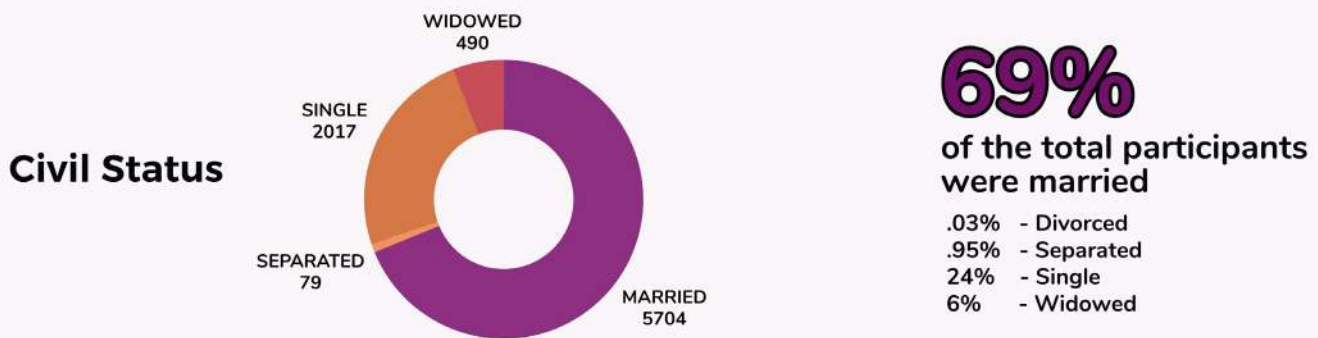

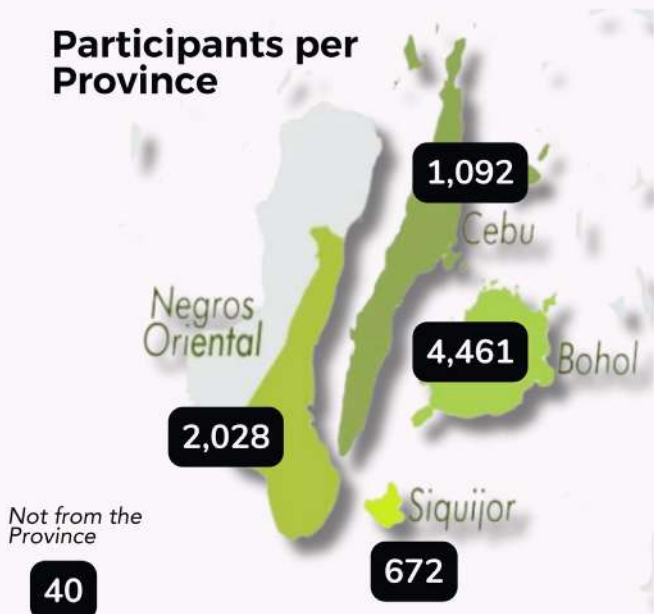

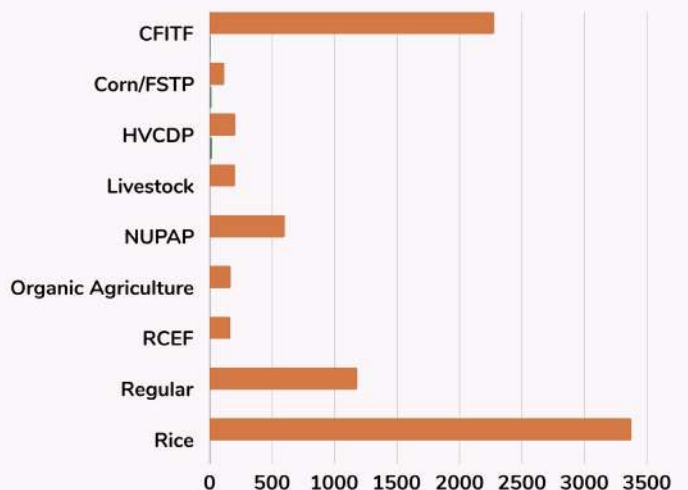
# 2023 PARTICIPANT'S DEMOGRAPHICS

# **Rice Competitiveness Enhancement Fund (RCEF)**



RCEF implemented the following:

Refresher Training on Inbred Rice Seed Production and Certification for Deputized and Designated Seed Inspectors last May 23-25, 2023 for Central Visayas with 20 AEWs trained.

Harmonization Sessions: Achieving Coherence in Extension Delivery in the Provinces of Negros Oriental and Siquijor which was conducted last September 4, 2023 at Dumaguete City with 22 participants attending.

Under the Digital Agriculture Course, there were two (2) batches conducted last February 7-9, 2023 and February 21-23, 2023 at ATI-RTC 7 Training Complex, Cabawan District, Tagbilaran City with 43 farmers and agricultural extension workers trained.





## National Urban and Peri-Urban Agriculture Program (NUPAP)

The achievements attained through the National Urban and Peri-Urban Agriculture Program (NUPAP) in 2023 encompassed the construction of nursery or greenhouse facilities and establishment of community/school gardens – complemented with the provision of gardening starter kit. Each kit comprised essential tools, including one shovel and one seedling tray, along with a selection of vegetable seeds, namely pechay, okra, kangkong, and eggplant, and IEC materials about vegetable production.

The following are the established school/community gardens in the region with 1,200 sets of garden starter kit distributed:

- 1) Japer National High School
- 2) Sagbang Farmers Association (SAGFA)
- 3) Pocket Garden Project, San Roque National High School
- 4) Langtad, Naga City, Cebu
- 5) San Jose, La Libertad, Negros Oriental
- 6) Sabang Vegetable Growers Association (SAVEGA)

Meanwhile, below were the established Nurseries:

- 1) PrimeTech Skills, Mantiha I, Danao City, Cebu
- 2) IPED Canggohob Highschool Nursery Garden

- 3) Anastacia and Anastacia Diversified Farm
- 4) Association of Farmers and Fisherfolks in La Union (AFFLA)

## Coconut Farmers and Industry Trust Fund (CFITF)

The Coconut Farmers and Industry Trust Fund Act (CFITF) otherwise known as Republic Act No. 11524 signed by President Rodrigo R. Duterte last February 26, 2021, mandates the creation of a 50-year CFITF, as provided under a coconut farming industry development plan.

Under Social Protection Component, ATI is tasked in the delivery of Training of Coconut Farmers and their Families; hence, the following are the 2023 accomplishments:

# Scholarship

## ***Educational Assistance for the Youth in Agriculture (EASY AGRI)***

Under EASY AGRI, ATI in Central Visayas has a total number of 14 scholars for Batch 1. Ten (10) enrolled in Bachelor of Science in Agriculture (BSA) with five (5) each enrolled at Bohol Island State University (BISU-Bilar, Bohol Campus) and Negros Oriental State University (NORSU) in Negros Oriental respectively.

Moreover, four (4) scholars are taking Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Biotechnology Engineering (BSABE) at BISU.

For Batch 2, another 14 scholars were added with 13 who took up BSA, six from BISU, one (1) each from Visayas State University (VSU-Baybay, Leyte) and Central Philippines State University (CPSU-Kabankalan Main Campus). Also another one (1) in BISU, taking up Bachelor of Science in Marine Biology, respectively.

In 2023, 12 scholars composed the Batch 3 with eight (8) enrolled in Bachelor of Science in Agriculture. Four (4) each from BISU and NORSU respectively.

While three (3) BSABE; two (2) from BISU and one (1) from Cebu Technological University (CTU-Barili Campus) and one (1) Bachelor of Science in Agribusiness from CTU.

## ***Educational Grants for Extension Workers (EDGE)***

Under EDGE, there are six (6) grantees from BISU taking up Masters in Agricultural Development major in Agriculture and Development and one from CTU-Carmen Campus taking up PHD in Fisheries and Aquatic Sciences.

# Learning Site for Agriculture (LSA)

With the institute's thrust of expanding partnerships to advance excellence in agriculture and fisheries extension. The ATI supports the establishment of Learning Site for Agriculture (LSA).

The LSA is a farm practicing applicable agricultural technologies, employing doable farming strategies and operating successfully, thus, worthy of emulation.

The LSA will serve as model or an example to showcase applicable agriculture technologies and agri-products/by-products processing technologies. In this way, they are seen to help improve capabilities of small farmers and other rural community members.

In 2023, ATI in Central Visayas received a total of 61 letter of intent from farmers who aspire to become learning site for agriculture. Out of this number, 39 were validated and 15 certified.

A total of nine (9) LSAs were granted financial assistance for the year. Eight (8) of which were fully released in a total amount of 1.1 Million Pesos and one (1) LSA on its first tranche.

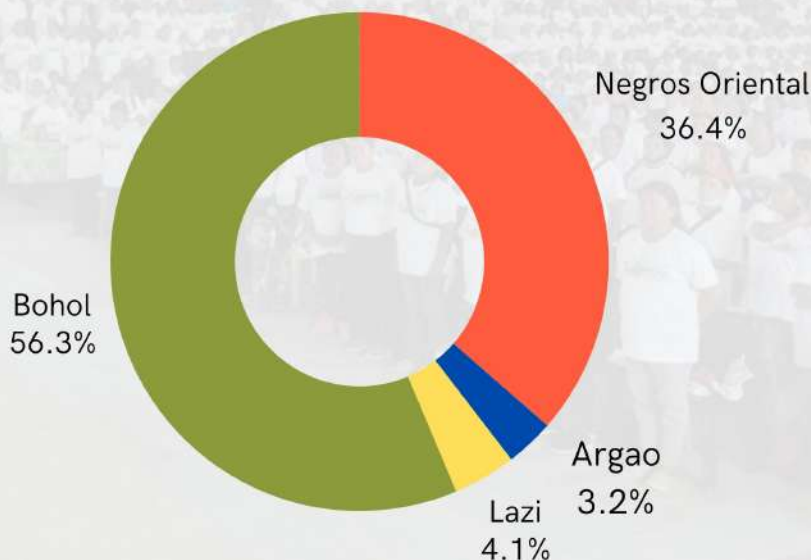
The poster presented was the developed innovation titled as e-Distribution of Knowledge Products (KPs) through “AgriBASA App”.

# Farmers Information Technology Services (FITS)

A total of 10 FITS Centers and Kiosks were successfully established through the RCEF program, with an additional two (2) Kiosks established under the regular program in 2023.

The focus of the RCEF program is on rice-producing municipalities, with the identified municipalities belonging to Negros Oriental and Bohol, designated as Region VII's rice-producing provinces covered by the RCEF initiative.

In Negros Oriental, five (5) Centers namely Amlan, Manjuyod, Sta. Catalina, Basay, and Vallehermoso, as well as 3 kiosks: Vicamo Farm FITS Kiosk in Valencia, J' Rodriguez Farm FITS Kiosk in Bindoy and Anahaw Integrated Farm in Sibulan have been established.

Meanwhile, Bohol has 1 Center and 1 Kiosk, which are Sevilla and Labonite Family Farm in Pilar, respectively.

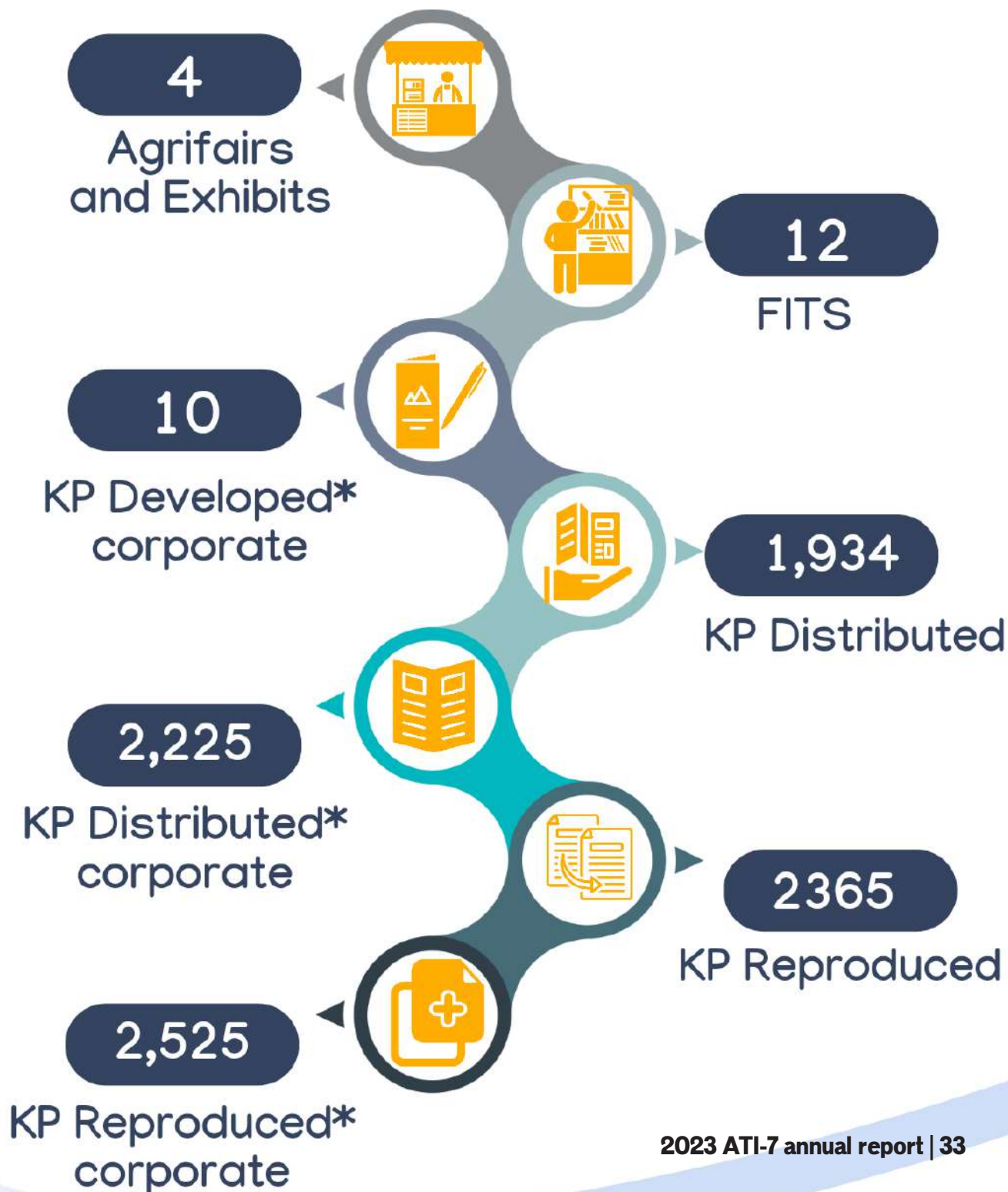

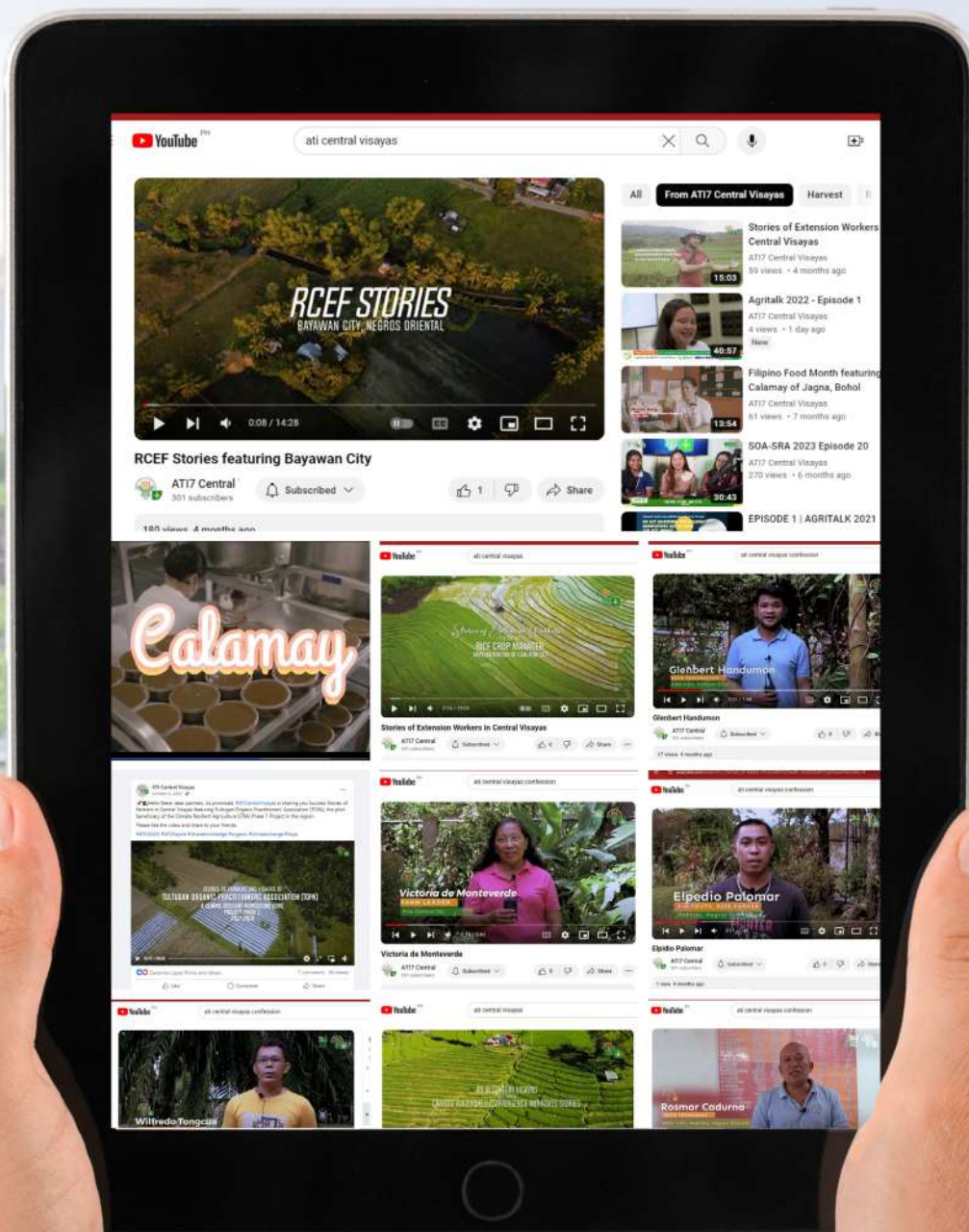

This area focuses on the need of extension agencies for policy support, planning, monitoring and evaluation mechanisms, human resource management, budget, infrastructure and facilities.*





Under SUPPORT, the ATI in Central Visayas is very much active in supporting activities in the region as well as to the Local Government Units of the island provinces in the Visayas.

Among the highlights under this theme include the following:

ATI-7 was among the selected centers in the network to undergo the face-to-face ISO 9001: 2015 Surveillance Audit on February 17, 2023 as well as during the Re-Certification last November 17, 2023.

Also, active in the Bohol Participatory Guarantee System Association (BPGSA) particularly in the conduct of Capability Building as well as present during the Inspection and Audit Activities respectively.

Moreover, ATI-7 also is an active partner of DA-RFO 7 especially during the latter's Agency In-house Research for Development and Extension Review where nearly 30 research studies presented were reviewed.

Meanwhile, with the threat of the African Swine Fever (ASF), ATI-7 disseminated Standees both in Cebuano and English on ASF Information to major seaports, airports and bus terminals in Central Visayas.



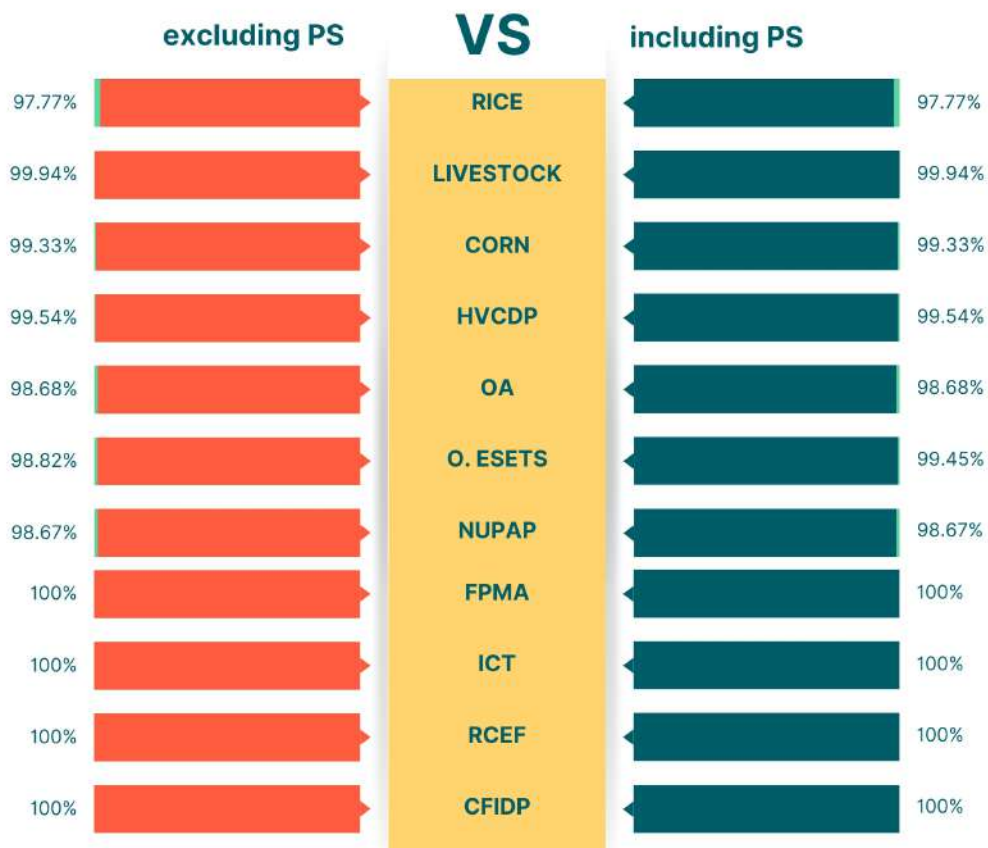
