Harvesting

Harvest time begins at 80-90 days after planting.

Production Management

Plowing

Plow the garden/plot.

Plot preparation

The measurement of the plots is 1 meter width by 10 to 20 meters.

Digging Holes

Dig holes with a depth of 15cm. distance between each plant is 50cm x 50cm.

Application of Organic fertilizer

Apply organic fertilizer to each hole at rate of 1 kilo per hill.

Sowing of Tomato Seeds

Grow the seeds in a seed box for 14 days.

Pricking and Transplanting

After 14 days from sowing, prick the seedlings and transplant them into the plot/

Trellising

After one (1) month from transplanting, support the tomato stem for straight growth with a one(1) foot bamboo stick.

Care and Management

- Water the tomato plants everyday preferable early in the morning.
- Apply organic fertilizer every 15th day.
- Spray probiotics (organic pesticide) once a week.
