CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE 2024 YOUTH INTERNSHIP

PROGRAM FOR CORN YOUNG FARMERS

The Agricultural Training Institute, in collaboration with the Department of Agriculture - National Corn Program will be implementing the **Internship Program for Corn Young Farmers**. It aims to provide opportunities for the youth to acquire the applicable knowledge, skills and practices specifically on corn-based agri-entrepreneurship. The farm partners shall mentor these interns on the farm activities within the corn value chain either through value adding, processing, or marketing.

In this regard, you are advised to conduct **the initial search for the potential applicants** of the youth internship program while waiting for the release of the approved implementing guidelines. Below are the eligibility criteria and documentary requirements for the two key players in this program:
