**A RESOLUTION DECLARING COVER AND PAGES AS THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND
RESPONSIVE BIDDER FOR PROCUREMENT OF PRINTING SERVICES FOR THE REPRODUCTION
OF DIGITAL FARMERS PROGRAM MODULES
(PHILGEPS REF. NO. 9653818/ ITB NO. ATI-CO-2023-06)**

BAC Resolution No. AC-02, s. 2023

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9184 otherwise known as “The Government Procurement Reform Act
“created the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) to ensure among others that the Procuring
Entity abides by the standard set forth by the said act;

WHEREAS, Section 10, Rule IV of the IRR-A of the 9184 provides that all procurement shall pass
through competitive bidding except as otherwise provided for under the Rule XIV;

WHEREAS, the **Procurement of Printing Services for the Reproduction of Digital Farmers
Program Modules**, not being an exemption, must necessarily pass through competitive
bidding;

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Training Institute (ATI) posted the Invitation to Bid for the
aforementioned Project with Approved Budget for the Contract Amounting to **Two Million
Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 2,550,000.00)** in PhilGEPS Website (**PHILGEPS
REF. NO. 9653818/ ITB NO. ATI-CO-2023-06**) and the ATI Website.

WHEREAS, in response to the said posting, six (6) prospective bidders bought the bidding
documents from the BAC Secretariat and submitted their bid proposals prior to the bid
opening held on May 3, 2023;

WHEREAS, during the Bid Opening, it was found out that having complied with all the eligibility/
technical and financial requirements, both bidders were rated as “**ELIGIBLE**” to participate in
the bidding and thus rated as “**PASSED**”;

ATI’s requirements (see attached Bid Evaluation Report and Post Qualification Report of BAC
TWG);

1. Declare **COVER AND PAGES CORP.** as the **LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER** for the Procurement of Printing Services for the Reproduction of Digital Farmers Program Modules;
2. Recommend for the approval of award of the said Contract to **Cover and Pages Corp.** and its Bid Amount as Calculated amounting of **Seven Hundred Thirty-One Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-Five Pesos (Php 731,865.00)**;
3. Recommend for the Approval by the ATI Director IV the foregoing findings/recommendations.
