A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING APPROVAL FOR ADOPTING ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT – NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT - SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT AND AWARD TO E-COPY CORPORATION

Section 53. 9 and Annex “H” D-8 of 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184

BAC Resolution No. AFU-03-16, s. 2024

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Training Institute Director/Head of Procuring Entity had approved Purchase Request (P.R.) No. ADMIN FUND 2024-01-01 procurement of heavy-duty repair machine for official use of DO, Accounting Office, HRMO, and PPD with Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Eight Hundred Sixty Thousand Pesos (Php 860,000.00)** in accordance to the End-users Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP); The said PR is not covered by Shopping under Section 52 of the IRR of RA 9184;

WHEREAS, as a general rule, all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding except whenever justified by the conditions in order to promote economy and efficiency, may resort to any alternative method of procurement;

WHEREAS, one of the functions of BAC is to recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE) the mode of procurement to be undertaken to meet the actual conditions and to ensure that the same is most advantageous to the government;

WHEREAS, the amount involved is within the threshold of Negotiated Procurement - Small Value Procurement as an Alternative Method of Procurement indicated in Annex “H” of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 for National Government Agencies (NGA’s);

WHEREAS, the receipt of one (1) quotation/proposal is sufficient to proceed with the evaluation thereof;

WHEREAS, two bidders submitted their price proposal; (1) Copy Data System Corporation and (2) E-Copy Corporation;

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group for ICT conducted a comparative evaluation of the submitted proposals;

WHEREAS, based on the evaluation, the Sharp BP20C25 offered by E-Copy Corporation was superior and complied with the specifications set by the end user. (attached is the TWG comparative evaluation);

WHEREAS, ATI ensures that the objectives and purpose of the procurement do not constitute an unnecessary, excessive, extravagant, or unconscionable expenditure;

WHEREAS, ATI-BAC shall validate the technical, legal and financial capability of the supplier/s by

submission of relevant documents or through other means of exercising due diligence prior to the recommendation of award to the Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE).

NOW THEREFORE, in the consideration of the foregoing, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED** to:

1. *Recommend Alternative Method of Procurement through Negotiated Procurement-Small Value Procurement as provided in Sec. 53.9 and Annex H (Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 for the above-cited goods/services/infrastructure projects/consulting services; and*
2. *Recommend the approval and award by the ATI Director IV of this Resolution and Purchase Order/Contract to **E-Copy Corporation** amounting to **Eight Hundred Thirty-Six Thousand Pesos (Php 836,000.00)**.*


