- WHEREAS, the Agricultural Training Institute (ATI) Director/Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE) had approved Purchase Request (PR) No. ISD (RICE) Fund 2024-05-28 to procure services for the Meals and Accommodation during the ICT4Ag2024 Congress on May 29-30, 2024 with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of One Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 178,750.00) in accordance to the End-user's Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP);
- WHEREAS, as a general rule, all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding except whenever justified by the conditions in order to promote economy and efficiency, may resort to any alternative method of procurement;
- WHEREAS, one of the functions of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is to recommend to the HoPE the mode of procurement to be undertaken to meet the actual conditions and to ensure that the same is most advantageous to the government;
- WHEREAS, Section 48, Rule XVI: Alternative Methods of Procurement of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", provides that in order to promote economy and efficiency, the procuring entity may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement provided that the most advantageous price for the government will be obtained;
- WHEREAS, the End-user has justified that resorting to Negotiated Procurement by Agency-to Agency is more efficient and economical to the government as indicated in the letter/justification to the BAC, with supporting document from the Boy Scouts of the Philippines as the Servicing Agency;
- WHEREAS, Section 53.5 of the 2016 Revised IRR allows the procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Project and Consulting Services from another agency of the GoP;
- WHEREAS, Annex "H" of the same IRR sets the conditions for the Agency-to-Agency enumerated as follows: (i) The Procuring Entity shall justify that entering into an Agency-to-Agency Agreement with the Servicing Agency is more efficient and economical to the government (ii) Servicing Agency has the mandate to deliver goods and services required to be procured or to undertake the infrastructure project or consultancy required by the Procuring Agency (iii) Servicing Agency has the absorptive capacity to undertake the project (iv) Servicing Agency owns or has access to the necessary tools and equipment required for the project;
- NOW THEREFORE, in the consideration of the foregoing, we, the members of the BAC, hereby RESOLVE AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED to:
 - Recommend Alternative Method of Procurement through Agency-to-Agency Procurement as provided in Sec. 53.9 and Annex H (Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 for the above-cited goods/services/infrastructure projects/consulting services; and
