**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING APPROVAL TO ADOPT NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT:  
AGENCY-TO-AGENCY AS THE ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF PROCUREMENT AND AWARD TO  
PHILIPPINE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTER**  
Section 53.9 and Annex "H" D-5 of 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184

**BAC Resolution No. AFU-01-04, s. 2025**

**WHEREAS**, the Agricultural Training Institute (ATI) Director/Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE) had approved Purchase Request (P.R.) No. **ADMIN FUND 2025-01-17** for the lease of venue with hall and meals for the conduct for the **Celebration of the ATI's 38th Founding Anniversary on January 31, 2025**, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Eight Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Six Pesos only (Php 897,726.00)** in accordance to the approved End-user's Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP);

**WHEREAS**, as a general rule, all procurement shall be done through competitive bidding except whenever justified by the conditions in order to promote economy and efficiency, may resort to any alternative method of procurement;

**WHEREAS**, one of the functions of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) is to recommend to the HoPE the mode of procurement to be undertaken to meet the actual conditions and to ensure that the same is most advantageous to the government;

**WHEREAS**, Section 48, Rule XVI: Alternative Methods of Procurement of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", provides that in order to promote economy and efficiency, the procuring entity may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement provided that the most advantageous price for the government will be obtained;

**WHEREAS**, the End-user has justified that resorting to Negotiated Procurement by Agency-to-Agency is more efficient and economical to the government as indicated in the letter/justification to the BAC, with supporting document from the **Philippine International Convention Center** as the Servicing Agency;

**WHEREAS**, Section 53.5 of the 2016 Revised IRR allows the procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Project and Consulting Services from agency of the Government of the Philippines (GoP);

**WHEREAS**, Annex H of the same IRR sets the conditions for the Agency-to-Agency enumerated as follows: (i) The Procuring Entity shall justify that entering into an Agency-to-Agency Agreement with the Servicing Agency is more efficient and economical to the government (ii) Servicing Agency has the mandate to deliver goods and services required to be procured or to undertake the infrastructure project or consultancy required by the Procuring Agency (iii) Servicing Agency has the absorptive capacity to undertake the project (iv) Servicing Agency owns or has access to the necessary tools and equipment required for the project;

**NOW THEREFORE**, in the consideration of the foregoing, We, the BAC Members, *hereby RESOLVE AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED* to:

- 1. Recommend Alternative Method of Procurement through Agency-to-Agency as provided in Sec. 53.9 and Annex H (Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 for the above-cited goods/services/infrastructure projects/consulting services; and**
