Guidelines on the Implementation of Specialized Training Courses for Local Farmer Technicians

The memorandum aims to develop Local Farmer Technicians (LFTs) a core of qualified and trained rice farmers as partners and active players in the development and promotion of modern rice production and post-production technologies | low-yielding rice growing barangays.

Salient Extension Provisions

Here are some of the guidelines and reference wit:

1. The Regional Training Management Team is composed of DA-RFU, ATI, PhilRice, RCPC, and NIA. They are in charge of the conduct of specialized training courses and technical assistance. Likewise, they can be tapped as resource persons;
2. The training program consists of two phases: Phase 1 covers all rice-based production technology topics and activities while Phase 2 deals with social technologies, facilitation and presentation skills. The course content and schedule depending on the needs of the farmers in the region.
3. Graduates of the 10-day Specialized Training Course are to conduct Climate Resiliency Farm Business School-Farmers Level.
